Six nations are set to compete on the 19th and 20th of November in the Swedish town of Oxelösund, host to this year's Under-21 Underwater Rugby Nordic Cup.



Two days of intense action will match up the National junior teams of Colombia, Denmark, Norway, Germany, Sweden and the Czech Republic.

Under the auspices of the Swedish Sport Diving Federation (SSDF), the competition offers some of the world's top young talent an opportunity to test themselves in international competition.
